Lisa Green, a native of Buffalo, New York, graduated from Fresno State University in 1980 and attended the University of San Diego Law School, graduating in 1983. While in law school, Mrs. Green wrote for the Law Review, was a member of the Moot Court Board, and received the Order of Barrister Award. She joined the Kern County District Attorney's Office as a law clerk in 1983 and became a Deputy District Attorney upon passing the Bar exam in 1983. She has prosecuted over 110 felony trials, the majority of those cases involving homicides and sexual assaults. Mrs. Green was promoted to Supervising Deputy District Attorney in 2001, and in 2009 was promoted to Chief Deputy District Attorney, the first woman in Kern County to hold that position. In 2009, Lisa will be running for the position of District Attorney.
